Board of Directors – Lawyer Member General Criteria & Expectations

Who?

Any regular member of the Nunavut Bar may apply with preference given to members who have northern experience, are resident of Nunavut, can participate in regular and urgent meetings for a 2 year minimum commitment

What ?

Agenda items will vary but would generally include review of grants and scholarship proposals

When?

The Foundation's preference is to meet at least every other month with urgent meetings called if they are needed or approval by E-Resolutions as needed

Where?

Meetings do not need to be attended in person and typically last between 60-90 minutes; Conference call link is available

Consolidation of Legal Profession Act R.S.N.W.T. 1988,c.L- 2 (Current to : May 2012)

Board of directors

52. (1) The affairs of the Foundation shall be conducted by a board of directors composed of

- (a) a person who is not a member of the Society and who shall be appointed by the Commissioner; and
- (b) four other persons to be appointed from among the members of the Society by the Executive in accordance with the rules.

Term

(2) The term of office of the members of the board shall be two years.

Chairperson

(3) The Executive shall designate one member of the board as chairperson.

Quorum

(4) Three members of the board constitute a quorum.
