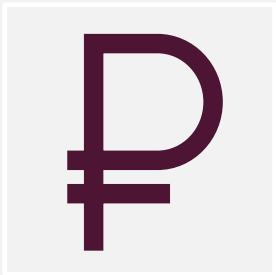
## **Cultural and Natural Wonders:**

# OTHER OPTIONS IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES



If the foreign worker does not qualify for any permanent immigration program, they may have the opportunity to settle in the Northwest Territories, where more immigration programs are available.

- Business Stream
  - Commitment to invest into starting a business;
  - Own at least 33.3% of a NWT company
  - Have the required financial means and language competency

# WORK PERMITS



## Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA):

- Required for most jobs
- As an employer, the Government of Nunavut generally not issue LMIA's
- Low-wage cutoff is set at \$42 per hour (except in some fields)

## International Mobility Program:

- Alternative for LMIA-exempt roles.

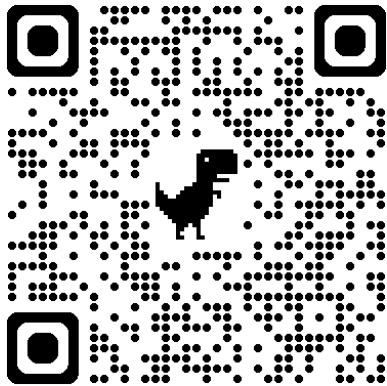
