STRONG PASSWORDS

Use strong passwords on all devices and accounts.

CREATING STRONG PASSWORDS

- Use at least 8 to 12 characters
 Use a combination of letters,
 numbers, and symbols
- Use at least 1 uppercase
- Do not repeat passwords
- Use uncommon and unusual words



PASSWORD PROTECTION


Shield paperwork, device screens and keypads from view when entering password.
