## NOTICE OF HEARING WITH RESPECT TO MICHAEL PENNER

On August 3rd, 2023, Shayne Kert, Chair of the Discipline Committee for the Law Society of Nunavut issued a Notice of Direction with respect to Michael Penner. In accordance with paragraph 24.1(1)(d) of the *Legal Profession Act*, members of the Discipline Committee Sarah White, Stephen Mansell and Merrilee Rasmussen were appointed as a Committee of Inquiry into the conduct of this matter.

It is alleged that in the course of representing client BN on a family law matter, Michael Penner engaged in professional misconduct by failing to perform all legal services undertaken on the client's behalf to the standard of a competent lawyer and failing to provide courteous, thorough, prompt, competent, timely, conscientious, diligent, efficient and civil service to the client as required by Sections 3.1-2 and 3.2-1 of the *Model Code of Professional Conduct*.

The Inquiry will take place August 27th, 2024, virtually, at 9:30am EDT. The Inquiry will be open to the public and interpretation is available upon request in Inuktitut.
